



Alejandro Giorgetti obtained his bachelor's degree in physics at the 'Universidad Nacional del Sur', Bahia Blanca, Argentina. He obtained a Ph.D. in Physical and Statistical Biology at the International School for Advanced Studies (SISSA), Trieste, Italy. After that, he spent three years in the Biocomputing lab. at the Universidad di Roma 'La Sapienza'. Nowadays, Alejandro Giorgetti is an Associate Professor of biochemistry at the University of Verona, Italy since 2018. Since his arrival at the Department of Biotechnology (2007) he has been the Principal Investigator of the group 'Laboratory of Applied Bioinformatics'. As a second affiliation, since 2015 he is the P.I. of the Structural Neuroinformatics group in the Institute for Advanced Simulation (IAS) / Institute of Neuroscience and Medicine (INM) (Computational Biomedicine (IAS-5/INM-9)), Forschungszentrum Jülich, Germany. His principal activities regard protein structural bioinformatics and computational biophysics aimed at understanding the molecular mechanisms underlying the interaction of membrane chemo and neuro-receptors with their cognate ligands. He has published 72 peer-reviewed articles and several book chapters. Among other journals, he is a member of the editorial board of Scientific Reports (Nature group).
